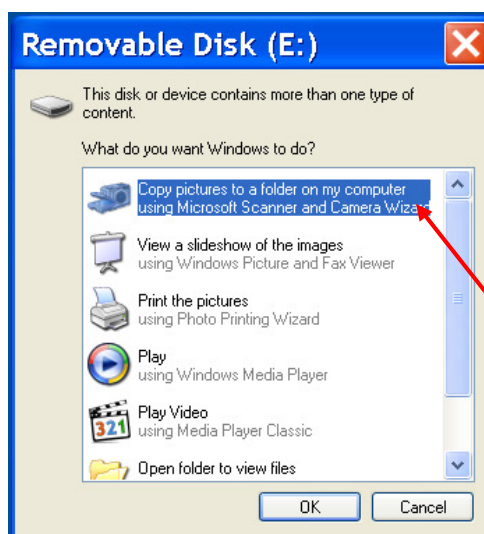



Downloading Pictures from a Digital Camera to a Computer (Windows XP)

Step 1 Plug the USB data cable into the camera. Plug the other end of the cable into a USB port on your computer, and turn the camera **ON**.

The following window will appear.



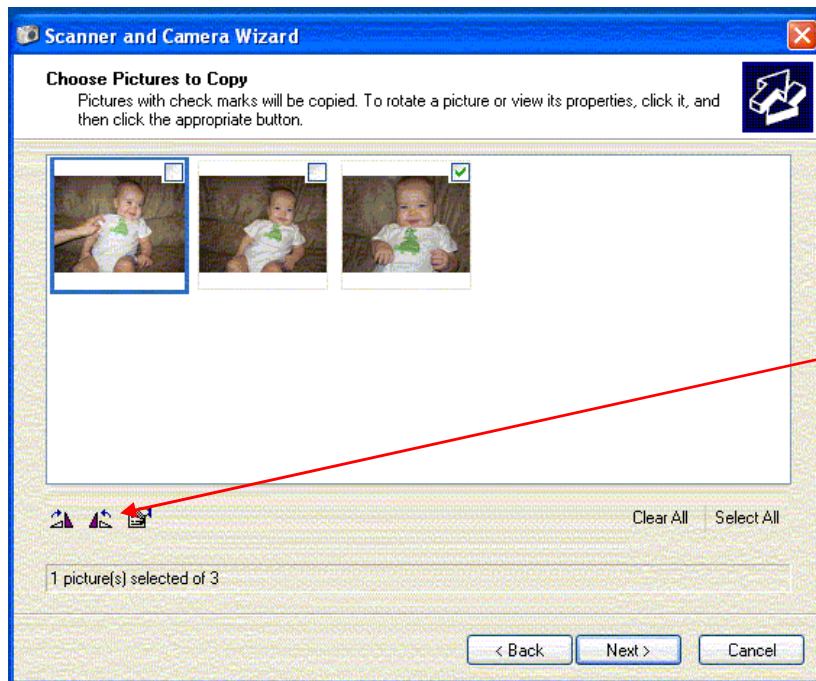
Step 2 Highlight (click on) the option that starts “Copy pictures to a folder on my computer.....” and then click the  button.

The Welcome screen will appear.



Step 3 Click the  button on the welcome screen

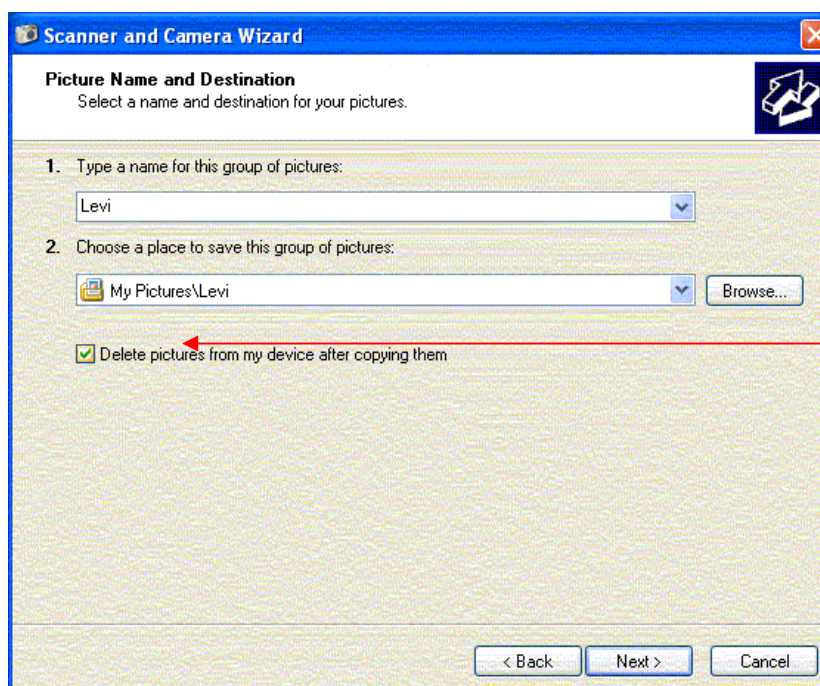
The following screen will appear.



Tip:

You can rotate the pictures, if you have any that are sideways, using the **rotate** buttons

Step 4 Put a tick next to the pictures that you want to download (Tip: If there are a lot of pictures on the camera and you only want a few, click the “Clear All” option and then tick the ones you want). Click the **Next** button.



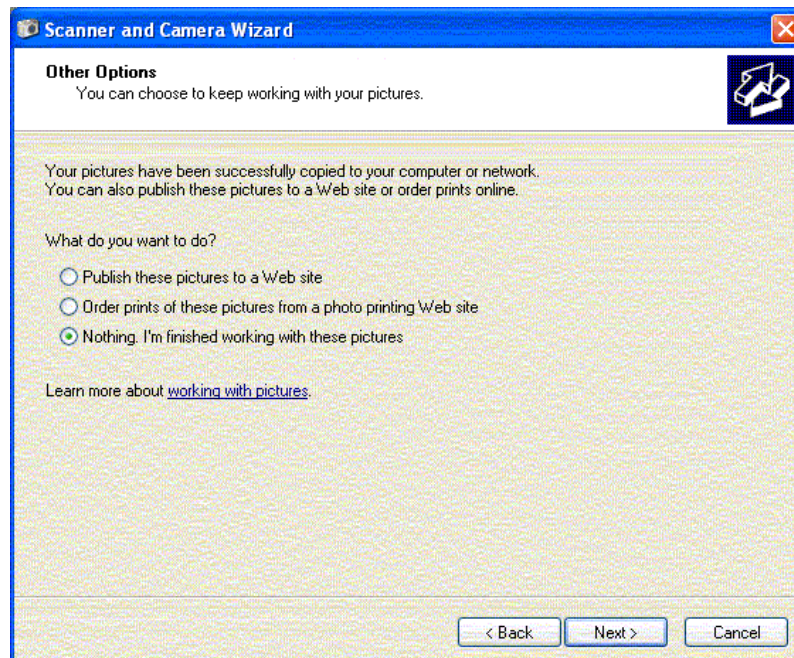
Tip:

You can delete the pictures from your camera after copying them by ticking the box

Step 5 In box 1. Give the group of pictures a name e.g. France Holiday 2011.
In box 2. Choose where you want to keep the pictures (usually My Pictures)

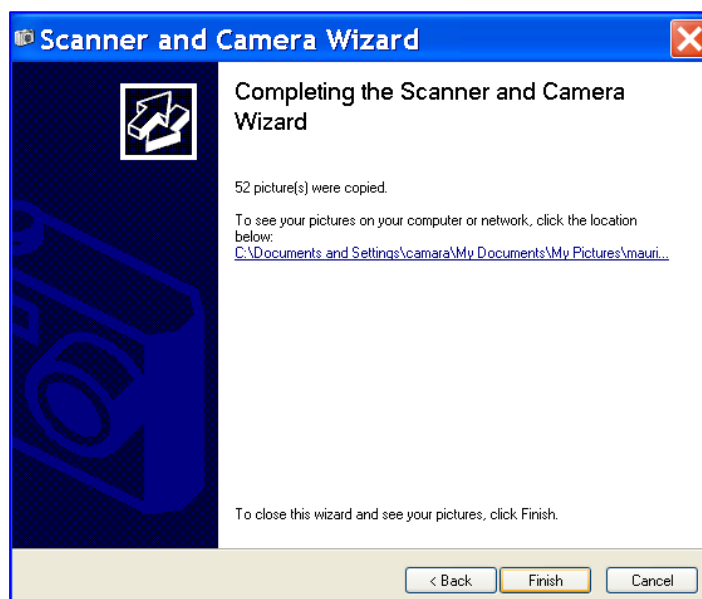
Click the **Next** button. The PC will start the copying process.

When the copying process has finished, The following Window will appear



Step 6 Select the option “Nothing. I’m finished working with these pictures”

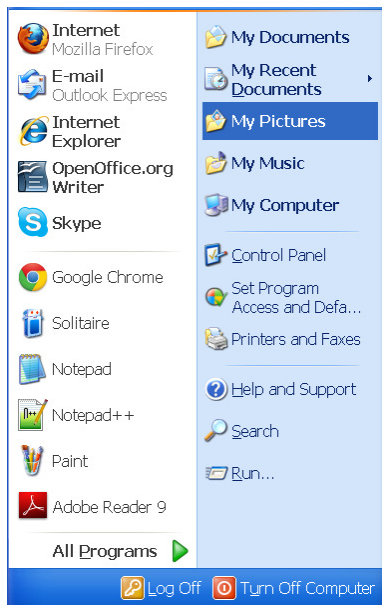
Click the **Next** button.



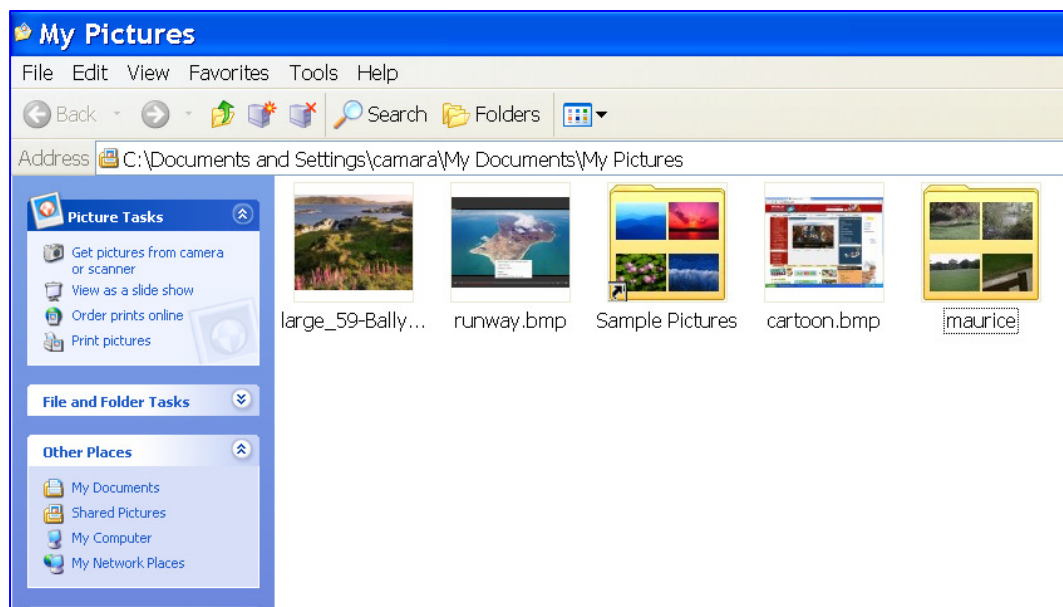
Step 7 Click the **Finish** button on the last screen and your pictures will be downloaded to folder that you selected

Step 8 Turn the camera **OFF** and disconnect the cable from the computer and the camera

Step 3 Click on the folder that contains the photos you want to view
